Announcement

It is hereby announced for the information of candidates who have applied for the post of Motor Vehicle Officer (Enforcement) in Transport Department, Haryana in response to advertisement No. 40/2024 that the Scheme/ Pattern of exam and Syllabus is as under:-

1. Syllabus for Screening Test:-

1. General Science: General Appreciation and understanding of science including matters of everyday observation and experience.
2. Current Events of National & International Importance.
3. The History of India and Indian National Movement.
4. Indian Culture
5. Geography of India: Physical, Economic and Social Geography of India
6. Indian Polity.
7. National and International Issues: current affairs and events.
8. Haryana: History, Economy, Polity & Culture.
9. Comprehension.
10. General Mental Ability.
11. Reasoning and Analytical Ability.
12. Basic Numeracy.

Scheme/Pattern of exam Screening Test:-

- a) Total number of MCQs: 100
- b) Total Marks : 100.
- c) Time duration of the exam : 02 hours.
- d) All questions carry equal marks.
- e) Each question will have five options. The fifth option will be meant for a situation where a candidate intends to leave the question un-attempted.
- f) One-fourth mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.
- g) In case a candidate neither attempts a question nor darkens the fifth option/bubble, then One-fourth mark will be deducted for each such question.
- h) Any candidate not darkening any of the five circles in more than 10% question shall be disqualified.
- i) The medium of exam will be English/Hindi.
- j) A candidate will have to secure a minimum of 25% marks to clear the screening test.
- k) Candidates four times the number of advertised posts, will be called for the next stage of selection process, provided that they have secured the minimum cut-off marks of 25%.
- l) The marks obtained by the candidates in the screening test will not be counted for final selection because it is meant only for shortlisting of candidates.

2) **Syllabus for Subject Knowledge Test**

The nature and standard questions in these papers will be such that a well-educated person will be able to answer them without any specialized study. The questions will be such as to test a candidate's general awareness of a variety of subject.

1. History of Modern India and Indian Culture: The History of Modern India, will cover history of the country from about the middle of the nineteenth century and would also include questions on important personalities who shaped the freedom movement and social reforms. The part relating to Indian Culture will cover all aspects of Indian culture from the ancient to modern times.
2. Geography of India: In this part, questions will on the physical, economic and social geography of India.
3. Indian Polity: This part will include questions on the Constitution of India, Political system and related matters.
4. Current National issues and topics of social relevance: This part is intended to test the candidate's awareness of current national issues and topics of social relevance in the present-day India, such as the following: Demography and Human Resources and related issues. Behavioral and social issues and social welfare problem, such as child labour, gender equality, adult literacy, rehabilitation of the handicapped and other deprived segments of the society, drug abuse, public health etc. Law enforcement issues, human rights, corruption in public life, communal harmony etc. Internal Security and related issues. Environmental issues, ecological preservation, conservation of natural resources and national heritage. The role of national institutions, their relevance and need for change.
5. Indian Economy: In this part, question will be on the planning and economic development in India, economic and trade issues foreign trade, the role and functions of I.M.F. world Bank, W.T.O. etc.
6. Development in the field of science and technology, communications and space; In this part, questions will test the candidate's awareness of the developments in the field of science and technology, communications and space, and also basic ideas computers.
7. Statistical analysis, graphs and diagrams: This part will include exercises to test the candidate's ability to draw common sense conclusions from information presented in statistical, graphical or diagrammatical form and to point out deficiencies, limitations or inconsistencies therein.

Scheme Pattern of Subject Knowledge Test


- a) Time duration of exam: 03 hours
- b) The medium of exam will be English/Hindi.
- c) Total Marks: 150
- d) Paper will be subjective type.
- e) No candidate will be called for the interview /viva-voce unless she/he secures a minimum of 35% marks in the test.

- f) The number of the candidates called for interview will be two times, including bracketed candidates if any, of the number of advertised posts provided that they have secured the minimum cut-off marks of 35%.
- g) The weightage of the Subject Knowledge Test will be 87.5%.

3. Interview

- a) The weightage of the interview will be 12.5%.
- b) Attendance in all the stages is mandatory.
4. The final merit list will be prepared by adding the marks of the Subject Knowledge Test and interview.
