

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: LSB 2026

Eligibility. All candidates who have been shortlisted as per the raw scores/normalized score are eligible to appear for the interview. Candidates seeking appointment for teaching subjects for which Online Screening Test was not conducted are also eligible if vacancies of these subjects have been announced. Candidates who have not been shortlisted for the interview as per the raw scores/normalized score system and those who have not qualified in the OST may however be considered for adhoc vacancies if they arise at any time during the academic session. For teachers being appointed on Adhoc appointments, possession of an OST Score Card and CTET/TET would not be a mandatory requirement but a preferred requirement.

Qualifications. Minimum qualifications for teaching staff at various levels, i.e., PGT, TGT and PRT will be in accordance with the guidelines issued by NCTE / CBSE / KV Sangathan. Though these minimum qualifications have been considered, in some instances AWES has raised the minimum standards further for the benefit of the students.

Detailed list of minimum qualifications for candidates is given at **Appendix C**.

Note:

(i) *A Post-Graduate with less than 50% aggregate marks in Graduation can also apply for the post of a TGT / PRT provided the candidate has scored a minimum of 50% or more aggregate marks in Post- Graduation.

(ii) Aggregate percentage will be based on the marks for the entire duration of Graduation/Post Graduation.

Qualified in CTET or appropriate State TET. CTET/TET is not mandatory for appearing in the Online Screening Test. However, applicable CTET/TET conducted by Central/State government is mandatory at the time of appointment as TGTs/PRTs. Therefore, candidates must ensure that they clear CTET/TET before their appointment as TGTs/PRTs. Candidates who have not qualified CTET/TET but found fit in all other aspects may be considered for appointment on vacancies which may be ADHOC in nature.

Candidates are required to ensure that they at least fulfill NCTE rules, regulations and notifications for minimum qualifications, KV Sangathan recruitment rules and regulations and Appendix- VII of CBSE Affiliation Bye-Laws 2018 before they register for OST.

Age and Experience Criteria of Candidates. As on 01 April of the year of appointment, the age and experience of the candidates and weightage to Army Spouses will be as under: -

2. **Computer Laboratory Assistant.** Minimum 10+2 with one year Diploma in Computer Science and knowledge of Hardware, Peripheral and Networking.

 - (a) Preferably an Ex-Serviceman of clerk category upto the age of 55 years.
 - (b) 5-10 years experience in Office Management, account handling as Head Clerk with high proficiency in staff duties and drafting experience.
 - (c) Computer Savvy – MS Office. etc.
 - (d) Educational Qualification – Minimum Graduate in case of civilian.
 - (e) Should not have any disciplinary case against him in the entire service.
4. **Administrative Supervisor**
 - (a) Preferably an Ex-Serviceman upto the age of 55 years.

5. **UDC/Accounts Clerk.**
 - (a) B. Com. or fifteen years of service as a clerk (for Ex-Servicemen). Computer literate (MS Office, Tally etc.)
 - (b) Computer Savvy (12000 key depression per hour). Knowledge of relevant software applications used by Schools.
 - (c) 5 years experience as a clerk or an accounts clerk in a reputed organization; preferably a school.
6. **LDC.**
 - (a) Graduate or ten years of service as a clerk (for Ex-Servicemen). Computer literate.
 - (b) Knowledge of Computer MS Office (Speed 12000 key depression per hour).
 - (c) Basic knowledge of accounting.
7. **Receptionist.** Same as laid down for LDC, with good communication skills.
8. **Para-medics.** 10+2 and diploma in nursing with minimum five years of experience. A female Paramedic should be given preference.
