**SCHEDULE AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR GROUP DISCUSSION AND INTERVIEW FOR MBA 5 YEAR PROGRAMME/BBA (HONS.)**

- Admission for these programs will be made on the basis of merit determined by composite marks of the candidates in the Entrance Test (80%), Group Discussion (10%) & the Personal Interview (10%) and applicable weightage(s).
- The number of candidates to be called for Group Discussion and Personal Interview will be five times the total number of seats available in the programme.
- Appearance in Group Discussion and Personal Interview is must for admission.
- The Group Discussion and Personal Interview of the short-listed candidates will be held at the Institute of Management Studies, Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra, wherein the candidates will have to present themselves at their own cost from **26.06.2026 to 27.06.2026 at 9.00 a.m.** onwards. Respective group of Interview will be notified on or before **25.06.2026** on the Admission Portal. No separate communications will be sent for Interview. Schedule for Personal Interview for left over seats will be notified on the university portal later on.

**SCHEDULE AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR BACHELOR OF FINE ARTS (BFA) PROGRAMME**

Admission for the programme will be made on the basis of merit determined by composite marks of the candidates in the Entrance Test (50%) and Practical Examination of Memory Drawing (50%) and applicable weightage(s). Entrance Test and Practical Examination will be conducted as per notified schedule.

**Note 2:**

- In case of any objection against the answer key or a question, the same may be submitted to concerned department/institute on the email Ids of the chairperson as per schedule mentioned above.
- Only the applicant can submit objection regarding a wrong question or answer key through his/her registered email Ids. The objection is to be supported by valid proofs.
- No objection against the answer key or a question will be entertained received after the date and time mentioned above.

4. The University may change the entrance schedule without any prior notice. The changed schedule, if any, will be notified separately. The changed schedule will be uploaded on the University Website. The candidates are requested to remain in touch with the University Website regularly.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTRANCE TEST**

1. **The candidates should check the scheme and syllabus on the university admission portal for the entrance test of the programme for which he/she has applied for.**
2. The Admit Cards for the Entrance Test will be generated through the University Admission Cell. The candidate can download the same before the date of conduct of Entrance Test. Roll No. and the Centre of the Entrance Test will be mentioned on the Admit Card. However, if any candidate due to any reason, cannot get his/her Admit Card up to two days before the Entrance Test, he/she must contact the office of the University Admission Cell. Such candidates must bring two recent passport size photographs duly attested by a Gazetted Officer or Head of the Department/Institute last attended by him/her to obtain duplicate Admit Card, 1-2 days before the Entrance Test. **No Admit Card will be issued on the day of Entrance Test.**
3. Candidates must not write or change any entry made in the Admit Card after it has been received by them.
4. Candidates must bring the Admit Cards with them at the time of Entrance Test. Without Admit Card, the candidates will not be allowed to appear in the Entrance Test.
5. Candidates should reach the Examination Hall well before time and should occupy their seats in the Examination Hall at least half an hour before the examination starts.
6. Candidates will be given a sealed Entrance Test Booklet containing questions as well as the OMR answer sheet 15 minutes before the start of the test. During these 15 minutes, the candidates should read the instructions and fill all the required particulars in the test booklet and OMR sheet.
7. Candidates must sign with a ball-point pen at the appropriate place on the front page of the question booklet as well as on the OMR answer-sheet.

8. Candidates should open the paper seal of the Test Booklet only when they are asked to do so by the Invigilator.
9. The OMR Answer Sheet must be returned to the invigilator before leaving the Examination Hall and the carbon copy of the OMR Sheet and Question Booklet may be carried by the candidates.
10. The candidates are advised to go through the instructions carefully given on the OMR Answer Sheet at the time of Entrance Test.
11. Candidates should bring their own good quality blue/black ball-point pens for making entries in the OMR Answer-Sheet. These will not be supplied by the University.
12. Candidates are advised not to fold, put any stray mark or do any rough work on the OMR answer sheet. However, the candidate can do rough work on the last page of Question Paper Booklet.
13. All the entries in the OMR Answer Sheet should be made strictly according to the instructions given to the candidates in the Examination Hall.
14. Use of books, papers, slide rules, log tables, cellular phones, calculators, pagers, digital diaries etc. will not be allowed in the Examination Hall.
15. If any candidate is found guilty of breach of any rules mentioned in the Prospectus or guilty of using unfair means, he/she will be liable to be punished by the competent authority of the University.
16. The candidates will be allowed to appear in the Entrance Test provisionally, subject to fulfilling the prescribed eligibility conditions/criteria given in the Prospectus. The candidates shall have no right to claim admission to any course merely due to their appearing in the Entrance Test.
17. To avoid impersonation, Videography of the candidates appearing in the Entrance Test and/or interview may be done by the University.
